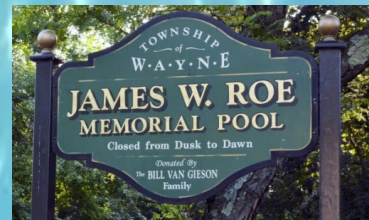
Session 3: Crystal Springs Family Water Park
